

As we begin 2022, America is facing the possibility of another "perfect storm" that dwarfs the devastation, destruction and loss of life incurred by the Andrea Gail and its crew.

However, unlike the Andrea Gail, we are not facing the forces of nature. We are facing the consequences of our own actions, and/or inactions, over which we had a great deal of control. We can't change history, but we can certainly change the path we are on and, perhaps, travel in a better direction. The first step might be to acknowledge exactly where we're at:

COVID MANDATES
