## **What are your "due process rights" and why are they so important?**

Make no mistake about it: The United States of America is the leader of the free world. The question is how long we can maintain that status if the constitutional due process rights of Americans continue to be denied in order to support private and political agendas.

The 5th and 14th Amendments to the United States Constitution protect your due process rights. In basic terms, due process embodies your right to be heard in a fair legal proceeding. In other words, it is due process that protects your right to "life, liberty or property." Nevertheless, most Americans don't think about due process until something goes wrong; and then it suddenly becomes the first thing on their mind!

Talk to folks that have gone through any type of legal proceeding (civil or criminal) that has threatened their "life, liberty or property" and you'll hear the same questions and criticisms over and over again: How can they do that? How come I never got a notice? The judge wasn't fair. The prosecutor tricked me. The police officer lied to me.

Unfortunately, despite state and federal constitutional protections, it is your job to assert your due process rights. If you don't, your chances of losing whatever is at stake is dramatically increased. You can lose your money or property in civil actions - or even

your freedom in criminal actions that call for incarceration.

Every American consumer that, for example, signs a contract, buys a car or house, invests money, opens bank or credit accounts, buys insurance, gets a job, gets married, has children, owns a business, etc. does so expecting that he or she will be "automatically protected" against due process abuses when there is a dispute. Please think again! More and more, Americans are finding out, after it's way too late, that they have, literally, waived some or all of their due process rights long before a given problem or dispute evolved. Simply put, they didn't understand (and in many cases didn't even read) the "fine print."

Until recently, few Americans realized or understood what a profound effect "due process" (i.e. the constitutional right to be heard in a fair legal proceeding) would have on their lives.

All of a sudden, social justice movements are taking center stage in America as self-serving private and political agendas are being exposed. Hard-working Americans are now finding out just how much of their freedom, independence, well-being, and money is being sacrificed and lost to line the pockets of the politically-connected. Even the courts are "looking the other way" all too often.

Currently, there is hardly a family in the United States that isn't facing one or more serious legal or financial issues. The pressures of day-to-day living are increasing

with more demanding regulatory and compliance requirements for all Americans.
